



Registrar's Order
Recommendation of Mailing of Notices and Verifications by the Personal Property
Registry – Postal Labour Disruption

Whereas subsection 42.4(2) of *The Personal Property Security Act, 1993* reads as follows:

42.4(2) Notwithstanding any regulation made pursuant to this Act or any other Act providing for registration in the registry, if, in the opinion of the registrar or the minister, the circumstances are such that it is not practical to provide one or more registry functions, the registrar or the minister may, by order, suspend all or any registry functions for the period during which, in the opinion of the registrar or the minister, those circumstances prevail.

And whereas at 3:00 p.m. on Thursday, September 25, 2025, certain registry services are unavailable due to a postal labour disruption by Canada Post, namely:

- 1) Mailed verification statements pursuant to section 20 of *The Personal Property Security Regulations*; and,
- 2) Mailed notices of registration, amendment or discharge pursuant to section 20.1 of *The Personal Property Security Regulations*.


And whereas at 6 a.m. on October 11, 2025 Personal Property Registry services to mail verification statements and notices of registration, amendment or discharge became available due to conclusion of the Canada Post labour disruption.

Therefore I, Jared Pashovitz, Registrar of Personal Property Security, do hereby order:

- 1) Recommencement of Services.

The mailing of verification statements and of notices of registration, amendment and discharge of registrations in the personal property registry is hereby recommenced.

Notice of this order shall be published in the Gazette and be posted to www.saskregistries.ca.
