Suspension of Registered Mail to the United States of America by the Corporate Registry

Whereas subsection 15(1) of *The Operation of Public Registry Statutes Act* reads as follows:

15(1) Notwithstanding any other Act or law, if, in the opinion of a registry officer or the minister, the circumstances are such that it is not practical to provide one or more registry services or functions, a registry officer or the minister may, by order, suspend all or any registry services or functions for the period during which, in the opinion of the registry officer or the minister, those circumstances prevail.

And whereas the Corporate Registry may send notices via registered mail pursuant to *The Business Corporations Act, 2021*, *The Non-profit Corporations Act, 2022*, *The Co-operatives Act, 1996* and *The New Generation Co-operatives Act*.

And whereas at 12:00 a.m. on Monday, August 29, 2025, the United States of America suspended their de minimis duty exemption for most imports resulting in registered mail sent by the Corporate Registry to the United States of America being treated as a parcel shipment and subject to customs processing.

Therefore I, Sheri A. Hupp, Registrar of Corporations and Registrar of Co-operatives, do hereby order that all notices sent by the Corporate Registry via registered mail to the United States of America be suspended and that these notices to the United States of America be sent by regular mail.

Notice of this order shall be published in the *Gazette* and be posted to www.saskregistries.ca.
